

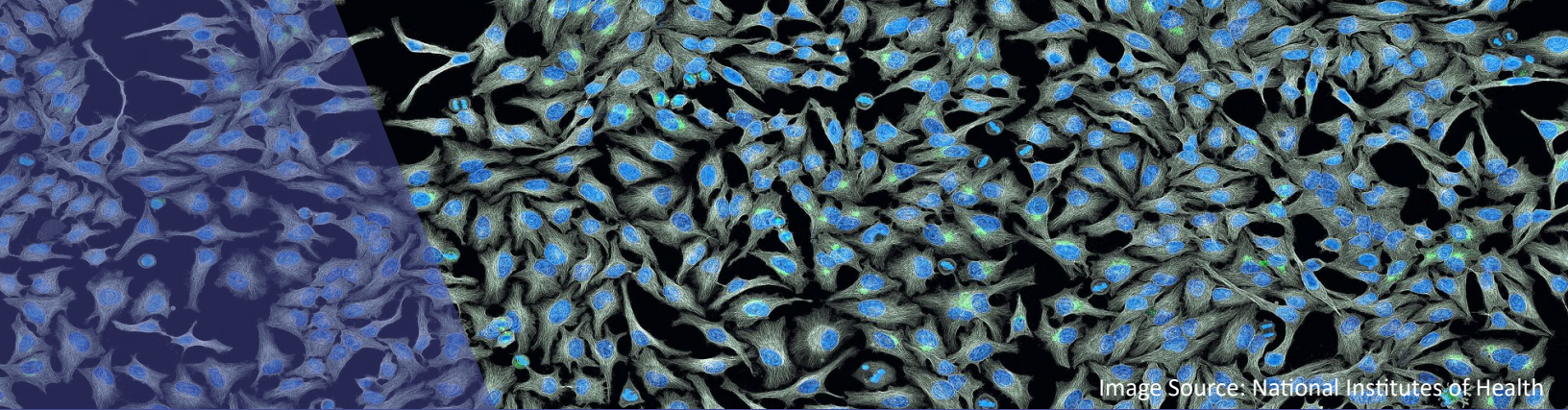

My research investigates the mechanisms underlying pancreatitis, with a new focus on the lymphatic vasculature and its interaction with the immune system. Despite its key role in resolving inflammation in many diseases, the lymphatic system's involvement in pancreatitis remains unexplored. This work is poised to deliver novel insights into pancreatitis biology and may uncover new therapeutic opportunities.
